Carers & Nurses

We provide carers and nurses to assist with a wide range of care needs. We have included some information below outlining what care nurses and carers can provide.

Personal Carers

Carers hold a minimum qualification of Certificate III in Aged or Community care work. This qualification allows carers to provide basic daily living assistance and care including assisting with showering, dressing, meals, toileting, shopping, attending appointments etc. A carer is the perfect choice for anyone who require a low to moderate level of care to remain independent in the home.

Enrolled Nurses

Enrolled nurses hold a Diploma in nursing and are able to provide nursing care including wound care, medication assistance and any other nursing care that may be required

Registered Nurses

A registered nurse is able to provide complex nursing care as well as administer certain drugs that aren't able to be provided by an enrolled nurse.

During your initial consultation we will identify what level of care we can offer that will best suit your requirements.

Paying for home care

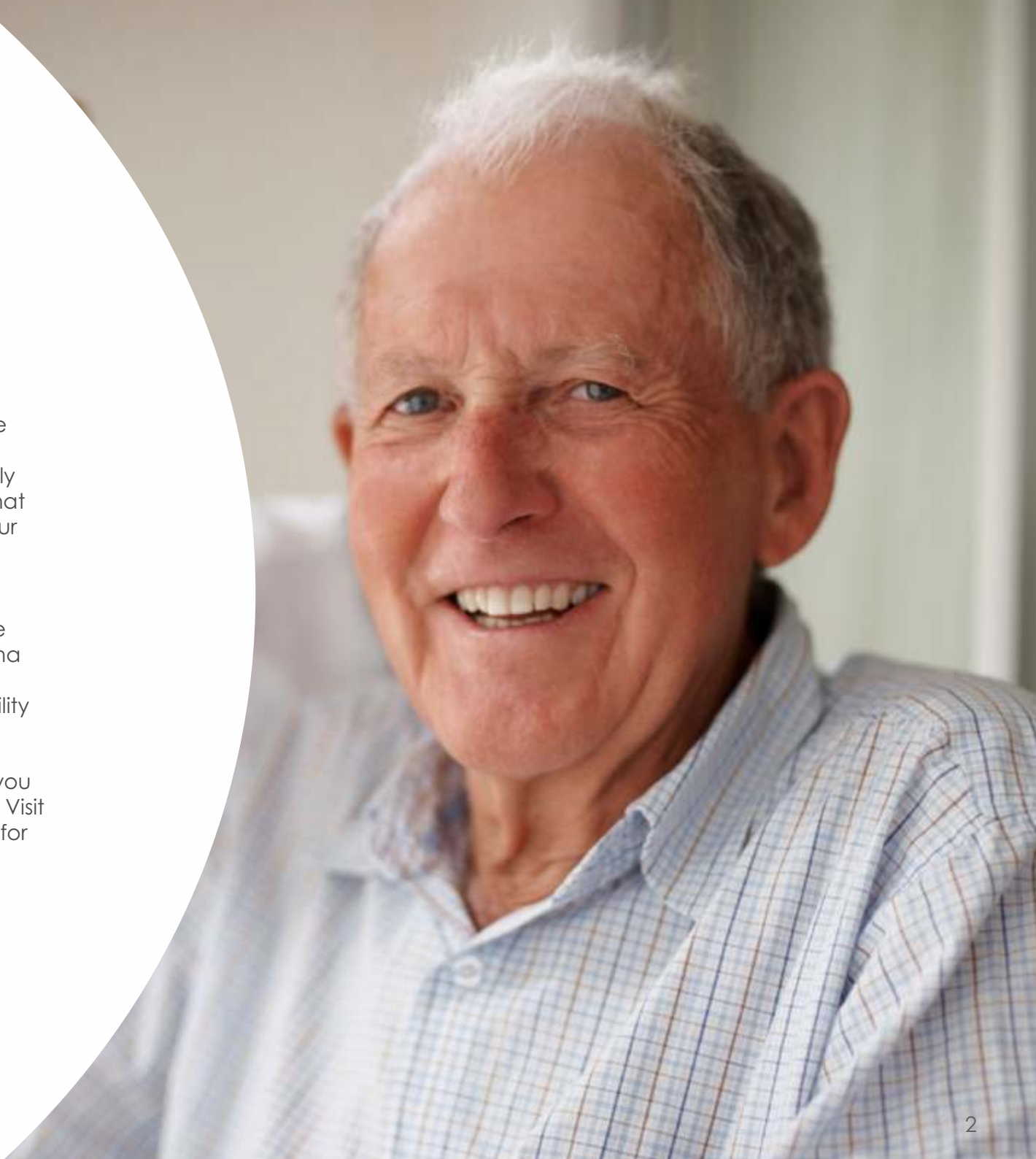
